

CARC net script

INTRO:

Welcome to the Columbia Amateur Radio Club (Wednesday/ Sunday) night net. Your Control Station tonight is (your call sign). The Columbia Amateur Radio Club conducts these nets on Sunday and Wednesday nights at 8:30PM. All licensed amateurs are welcome to participate. This net is conducted on our local repeater: 147.330 located near Columbia, SC using a PL tone of 156.7 hertz.

EMERGENCY OR PRIORITY TRAFFIC:

At this time do we have any Emergency or Priority Traffic? If so, please call Net Control with your traffic giving your call sign phonetically. (Reply as needed)

ROUTINE TRAFFIC:

This net is a discussion and information net . If you have routine traffic, please wait until the end of the net to pass that traffic.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

At this time do we have any announcements for the net such as *General Information, Events, Ham Fests, VE Testing*, etc? If so, please call net control with your call sign phonetically.

MOBILE, PORTABLE OR FIRST TIME CHECK-INS:

At this time do we have any mobile, portable, or first time check-in? If so, please call net control, let it drop for a couple of seconds to ensure no doubling, then call back in with your call sign given phonetically and slowly, your name and location, and whether or not you wish to be short time. Please call net control at this time. *(After a few check-ins, acknowledge those stations, then resume check-ins)*

TOPIC:

Before we begin taking check-ins, think about our topic tonight which is..... When you share, if there is anything else you'd like to bring up, please feel free to do so.

CHECK-INS:

At this time we will take routine check-ins. When checking in, please call net control, let the repeater drop for a couple of seconds to ensure no doubling, then call in slowly with your call sign given phonetically, your name, location, and whether or not you will be short time. At this time we will take check-ins A thru L. If the suffix of your call sign begins with A thru L please call net control. *(After a few check –ins, acknowledge those stations, then resume check-ins all the way from A thru Z)*

(Discuss the topic by acknowledging each station in order of check in. Toward the end of the list of stations that weren't short time, put out a last call for check-ins, then continue the topic discussion until all participating stations have had a turn)

CLOSING:

Thank you to the ___ amateur radio operators who checked in tonight. *(Quickly review the announcements made earlier)*. Remember that you can keep up with club news and events at our website: W4CAE.COM. Again thank you and the repeater will now be returned to regular use. 73 to all! (Your call sign) Clear.
