# CARC Monthly Meeting Minutes for 2 October 2018

<u>Introductions and Opening</u>: Club President Earl Dean (W4ESD) welcomed everyone to the meeting. Clark Frady (K4HI) was thanked for club use of the K4HI repeater while repair of the normal club repeater is in progress.

<u>Financial Report</u>: As of 30 Sep 2018, the balance was \$2464.91 and 155 members. The club's appreciation was given to those who donated to the antenna repair project. The club was able to pay for the antenna out of the donations.

<u>CARC Net Report</u>: Net Manager Gary Anderson (K4HGA) reported that there were 9 nets during September. A total of 281 check-ins, an average of 31 per net.

#### **Meeting Announcements:**

- Earl reminded everyone, if possible, to donate QST magazines to lobbies and reception areas to help with amateur radio operator recruiting.
- Next testing session should be the second weekend of December. Check the SCHEART site for more details.
- Earl mentioned that he would like to get a "Testing Go Team" together to assist with testing. The team would do testing on a more "as needed" basis for special requests.
- Gary suggested magnetic vehicle signs be purchased for event support vehicles, identifying that they are with the Columbia club and event support. Will be discussed further in the November meeting.
- Gary advertise the club polo shirts. \$30 per shirt, additional cost for XX sizes.
- Mike Wieber (N4BQQ) advertised there will be a Calhoun County ARES meeting on 2 October at the Town & Country restaurant in St. Matthews at 1800.
- Earl reminded everyone that the Rockhill club is having their Hamfest on 6 October.
- The club will be having a "yard sale" on 13 October in the Kmart parking lot (Two Notch and Parklane) starting at 0800.
- Following the yard sale, at 1000, Ronnie Livingston (W4RWL) will be having a Richland County ARES (Amateur Radio Emergency Services) meeting by the SCHEART communications trailer in the Kmart parking lot.
- Gary mentioned that he will have a simplex net after the normal club net on the first Sunday and Wednesday of the month. Immediately after the regular net, change to simplex 146.400.
- Tammy Livingston (N4TAL) announced that today, 1 October 2018, was National Homemade Cookie day. She brought cookies for everyone. But self-control was requested because once everyone had a cookie, she took several pictures of the club holding their cookie up.
- Tammy also mentioned that November will be ARRL elections and that all ARRL members should receive a ballot in the mail (US Postal Service mail).

  contesting group have actually hosted the event with the Columbia club donating \$300 for awards
  and certificates. He would like to see the club get back into supporting the QSO party or turn it over
  to the Swamp Fox group. The idea of the SC QSO Party is for participants to contact as many
  (preferably all) counties in South Carolina. Additional bonus stations are set up also. Several
  members of the club will try to get with the Swamp Fox group to coordinate the QSO party
  operation.

- Dan Cunningham (K9DBC) and Mike Magnuson (N7ETA) made a list of the sellable items from the
  "estate sale" for Mr. Robert Taylor. The items will be at the 13 October yard sale. Future estate sale
  requests will be handled by two or three volunteers to look over possible items and determine fair
  value price for the estate executors.

<u>Presentation</u>: Doug Anderson (W4NWS), from the Columbia National Weather Service (NWS) office gave a presentation on Weather Spotting and Communications. SkyWarn Weather Spotting is available on line (see links at end of minutes) or by request, may provide on-site training for groups. SkyWarn Weather Spotters provide "ground truth" to electronic observation (radar, satellite, etc.). Radars look more at cloud activity and not so much of what is actually occurring at ground level (rain, hail, etc.).
